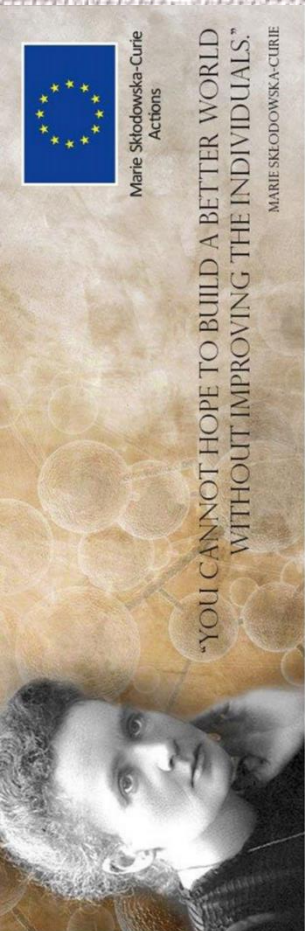

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA)



The MSCA have **5** main actions

Doctoral Networks

implement doctoral programmes (including joint doctorates and industrial doctorates) **by international partnerships** of organisations from different sectors. They train highly-skilled doctoral candidates, stimulate their creativity, enhance their innovation capacities and boost their employability in the long-term.

Postdoctoral Fellowships

support researchers' careers and foster excellence in research and innovation. Researchers holding a PhD can carry out their research activities, acquire new skills and develop their careers abroad, whilst developing competences in non-academic sectors and working within interdisciplinary teams.

Staff Exchanges

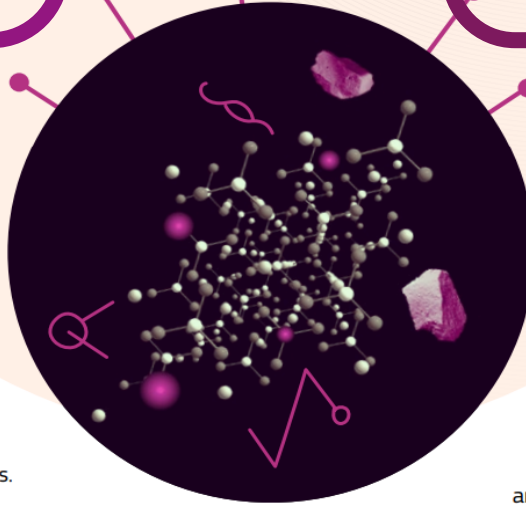
encourage short-term international and inter-sectoral exchanges of research and innovation staff through sustainable, collaborative projects in Europe and beyond. By doing so, they enhance knowledge and skills transfer and increase organisations' research and innovation capacities.

MSCA and Citizens

brings research and researchers closer to children, families and the public at large through the European Researchers' Night - the annual research communication and promotion event taking place at the end of September across EU Member States and Horizon Europe Associated Countries.

COFUND

co-finances regional, national and international doctoral and postdoctoral programmes for researchers' training and career development. The COFUND action spreads MSCA's best practices by setting high standards and excellent working conditions, and boosts training and international, interdisciplinary and inter-sectoral mobility.



Main Aim

The MSCA strongly contribute to excellent research, boosting jobs, growth and investment by equipping researchers with new knowledge and skills and providing them with an international as well as inter-sectoral exposure (including through academia-business collaboration), to fill the top positions of tomorrow.

5 Different Actions (min. conditions)

Postdoctoral Fellowships

- Individual application with a supervisor and host institution for post-doctoral research
- Max. 8 years research experience after PhD (new rule)
- Research opportunity in Europe and in the world
- Career development opportunity with mobility rule
- Resubmission is not possible if stayed under threshold (70 over 100)

Doctoral Networks

- At least 3 different partners from 3 different countries
- At least 1 EU MS/AC participation in the consortium
- Recruitment of PhD Fellows with EU funding
- Creation of Standart / Joint / Industry Doctorate Programmes
- Resubmission is not possible if stayed under 80 over 100 as score

Staff Exchange

- At least 3 different partners from 3 different countries
- Possibility to collaborate with non-European Countries
- Research, Technical, Administrative Staff Exchanges among partners with secondment method
- Top-up to the salary of the staff (no recruitment)

COFUND

- proposals for new or existing doctoral or postdoctoral programmes with an impact on the enhancement of human resources in R&I at regional, national or international level

MSCA and Citizens

- aims to bring research and researchers closer to the public at large, to increase awareness of research and innovation activities and to boost public recognition of science and research education.
- 1 day event in September in every funded organisation

MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships



Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF): Objectives

- Foster excellence through the implementation of a research project;
 - Enhance the creative and innovative potential of researchers holding a PhD (training on transferable skills & career development);
 - Focus on i3 (international, inter-sectoral, interdisciplinary) mobility;
 - Bridges with and exposure to the non-academic sector.
- All scientific fields (including Euratom-related areas)

Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF): Types of Action

PF is a mono-beneficiary action to support post-doctoral research and careers and has the following options:

- ✓ European Postdoctoral Fellowships coming to Europe from any country in the world or moving within Europe;
- ✓ Global Postdoctoral Fellowships outside EU Member States and Horizon Europe AC.

Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF): Participation

Participating organisations*

- Legal entity in an EU Member State or HE Associated country

Researchers:

- in possession of PhD at the call deadline (successful defense before call deadline);
- up to 8 years research experience after PhD (exceptions: career breaks, work outside research, research outside Europe for reintegrating researchers,...)
- **Nationality:**
 - **EFs:** any nationality
 - **GFs:** nationals or long-term residents of MS or HE AC *;
- **Mobility rule:** not resided/had main activity in the country of
 - **EFs** the beneficiary
 - **GFs** host organisation for more than 12 months in the 36 months before call deadline

* *Organisation: legal entity established in Specific eligibility criteria for PFs supported by Euratom:
an EU Member State or Euratom AC
Researcher: nationals or long-term residents of an EU Member State or a Euratom AC*



Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF): Conditions

Duration

- **EFs:** 12-24 months;
- **GFs:** 24-36 months (12-24 outgoing phase + 12 months mandatory return)

Secondments (non compulsory) Worldwide

- **EFs:** not more than 1/3 of total of project
 - **GFs** not more than 1/3 of total of outgoing phase + a max 3 months at beginning of the project at the beneficiary (to be deducted from the outgoing phase)
- Note:** encoded in Part A (Call specific questions)

Non academic placement (NAP) (non compulsory) EU MS or HE AC

- Additional period of max 6 months after project completion
- Note:** encoded in part A as participant organisation + letter of commitment

ERA Fellowships (widening activities)

- No separate application or evaluation – integral part of the MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships call application form;
- For specific countries* – available in Work Programme;
- Must be submitted by a host institution from a ‘Widening’ country;
- Only for EFs, GFs don’t qualify;
- Only proposals scoring over 70% in the PF call will be considered and failed to reach an adequate place in the ranking to be funded under that call;
- Timing aligned with PF call.

NOTE: “call specific question” to be completed in the PF submission for EF to indicate willingness to participate in this call (only if host organisation is a qualifying country)

- *Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czechia, Estonia, Greece, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia and all Associated Countries with equivalent characteristics in terms of R&I performance (Albania, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Kosovo 2, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Serbia, Turkey, Armenia, Georgia, Moldova, Morocco, Tunisia, Ukraine, Faroe Islands) and the Outermost Regions (defined in Art. 349 TFEU). Guadeloupe, French Guyana, Réunion, Martinique, Mayotte and Saint Martin (France)*

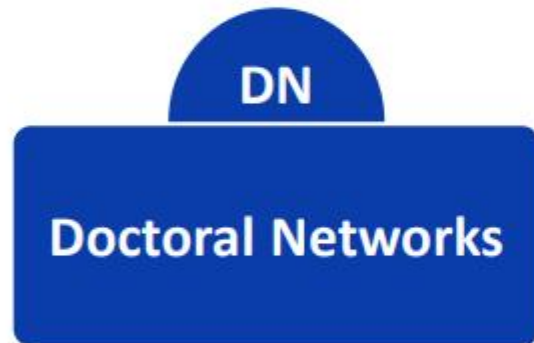

Doctoral Networks – Modes of implementation

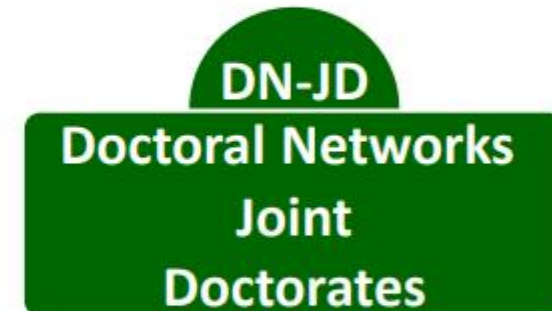
3 modes

What are Doctoral Networks?

Multi-beneficiaries Actions to set up **doctoral programmes** comprising:

- **Doctoral Networks (standard):** Training in academia and/or industry
- **Industrial Doctorates:** Training in academia and industry, Joint supervision
- **Joint Doctorates:** Joint collaborations leading to a joint/double/multiple doctoral degree, Joint selection and supervision; pre-agreement for joint degrees required

Doctoral Networks – 2023 Features

Size: Up to **540 person-months** for all implementation modes

Duration:

- **Programme:** max. 48 months for Standard DN and DN-ID; **max 60 months for DN-JD**
- **Fellowship:** between 3 and 36 months for Standard DN and DN-ID; **max 48 months for DN-JD**
- **Secondments:** worldwide, up to 1/3 of the fellowship duration for Standard DN; **no limitation for DN-ID and DN-JD**
- **Industrial doctorates (DN – ID):**
 - At least 50% in the non-academic sector (can be in the same country as the academic host organisation); non-academic sector as beneficiary or AP
 - Academic and non-academic organisations jointly supervise
- **Joint doctorates (DN – JD):**
 - Enrolment in a joint/double or multiple PhD (delivered by entities located in at least 2 MS/AC)
 - Joint admission, selection, training, supervision, governance
 - Letters of pre-agreement to deliver joint/double/multi degrees (template)

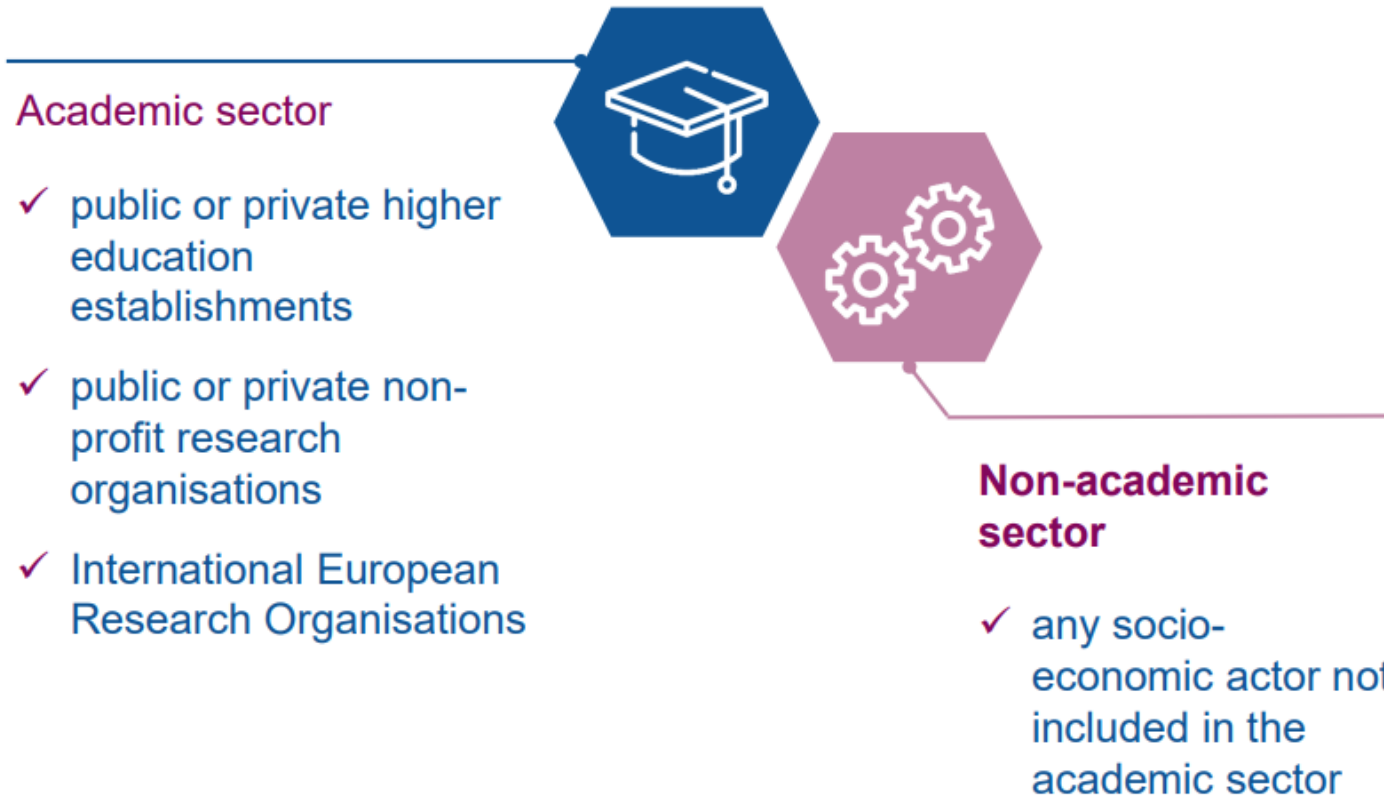
Doctoral Networks – Eligibility Conditions

- At least **3 independent legal entities**:
 - Each established in a different EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Country
 - Minimum of 1 beneficiary from an EU Member State
- **All beneficiaries must recruit at least one doctoral candidate.** They are required to host at their premises and supervise recruited researchers, or use associated partners linked to them to do so
- **Not more than 40.0% of the EU contribution may be allocated to beneficiaries in the same country** or to a single international organisation.
- **Specific eligibility conditions for Industrial and Joint Doctorates**
- **!** Re-submission restrictions for proposals scoring below 80% in Call 2022

Doctoral Networks – Eligible Participants

- **Who can apply?**
 - Any Legal Entity from anywhere in the world
 - But not all applicants are automatically eligible for funding
- **Consortia** of:
 - Universities, research institutions and research infrastructures
 - Businesses including SMEs
 - Other socio-economic actors
- No minimum / maximum number of **Associated Partners**

Doctoral Networks – Academic / non-academic sectors



Doctoral Networks – Eligible Countries

EU Member State (MS): 27 countries/ overseas territories

Associated Country(AC): Albania, Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Faroe Islands, Georgia, Iceland, Israel, Kosovo, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Norway, Serbia, Tunisia, Turkey, Ukraine

* *Morocco, United Kingdom*

Note: Switzerland is **not** an associated country

Third Country (TC): any other country (n.b. Annex A list of countries that can receive funding)

Doctoral Networks – Eligible Researchers

- Researchers must be **doctoral candidates** (not already in possession of a doctoral degree at the date of recruitment)
- Be recruited following an **open, merit-based and transparent recruitment**
- Researchers must be **enrolled in a doctoral programme, in at least 1 EU Member State/Associated Country (at least 2 for Joint Doctorates)**
- **Any nationality**
- **Mobility rule:** must not have **resided or carried out main activity** in the country of the recruiting beneficiary for more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately before their recruitment date.

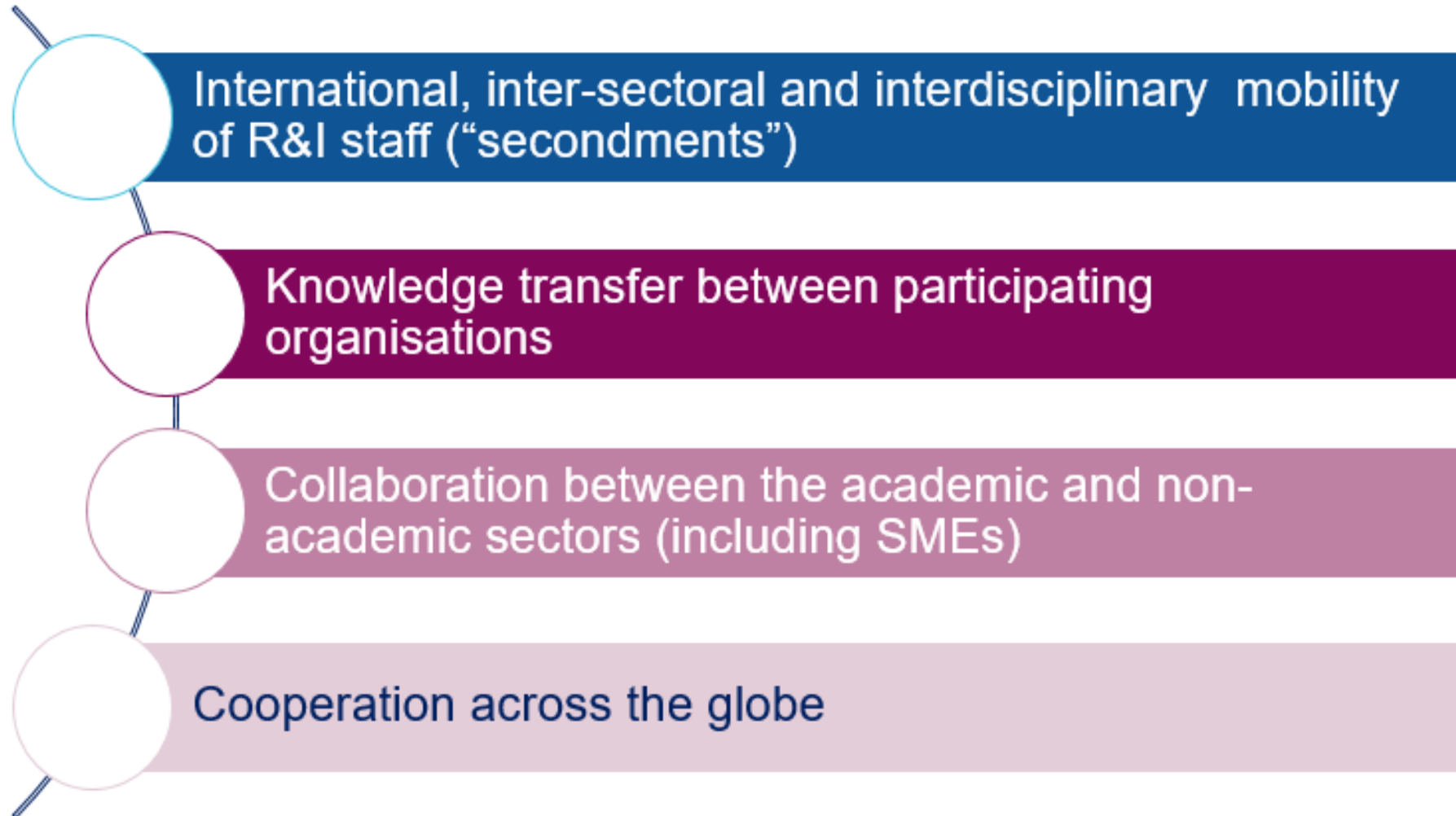

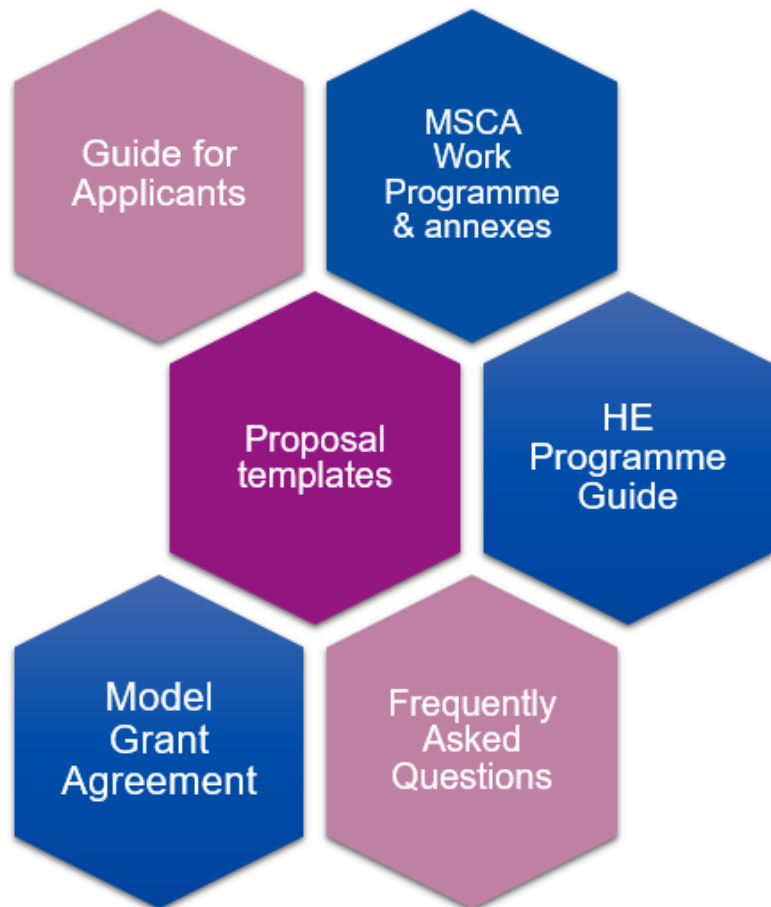
